

ORDINANCE NO. 1292

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 4 OF CHAPTER 6 OF THE RALSTON MUNICIPAL CODE, RABIES CONTROL; TO REPEAL ALL PROVISIONS OF THE RALSTON MUNICIPAL CODE WHICH ARE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE THAT SAID ORDINANCE BE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALSTON, NEBRASKA.

That on the 21st day of September, 2021, the Ralston City Council conducted a regularly scheduled public hearing at which it considered amending Section §6-401 of Article 4 of Chapter 6 pertaining to Rabies Control. Upon consideration of such amendment, the Ralston City Council approved said amendment to Section §6-401 so that after passage of this ordinance said sections shall read:

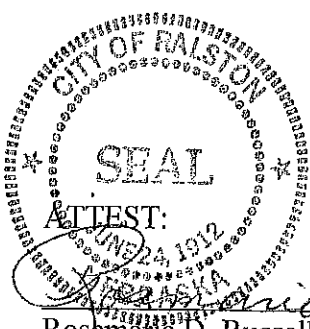
§ 6-401 RABIES; VACCINATION; REQUIRED

Every animal required to be licensed by this Chapter shall be vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian. Young animals shall be vaccinated within 30 days after they have reached three months of age, one year after initial vaccination, and thereafter triennially, according to manufacturer's guidelines. Unvaccinated animals acquired or moved into the city must be vaccinated within 30 days after purchase or arrival, unless under three months of age as specified above. It shall be unlawful for the owner of any animal required to be vaccinated herein to fail to provide to an animal control officer or any other authority proof of current vaccination against rabies. Any and all Ordinances or portions thereof, which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This Ordinance becomes effective upon passage by the Mayor and City Council of the City Council of the City of Ralston, Nebraska and upon its publication as provided by law.
