

**ORDINANCE NO. 1301**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 2-104 OF THE RALSTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLED “BOARD OF HEALTH”; TO REPEAL PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE THAT SAID ORDINANCE BE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALSTON, NEBRASKA.

That on the 1st day of March 2022, the Ralston City Council conducted a regularly scheduled public hearing, following notice and publication as required by law, at which it considered revising Chapter 2, section 104, of the Ralston Municipal Code. Upon consideration of such, the Ralston City Council approved the revision of §2-104 so that after passage of this ordinance said section shall read as follows:

**§2-104 BOARD OF HEALTH**

1. Members, organization and meetings. The Board of Health shall consist of five members consisting of: the Mayor, who shall serve as chairman; the Police Chief, who shall serve as secretary and quarantine officer; the President of the City Council; a physician who shall serve as the medical advisor, and one other member. The physician and other member shall be appointed by the mayor with the approval of the city council, and shall continue to serve at the pleasure of the Mayor. The Board shall meet at such times as the Mayor or City Administrator may designate. A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the purpose of doing business. The City Clerk shall keep the full and correct minutes and records of all meetings which shall be public records.
2. Powers and duties. The Board shall enact rules and regulations, having the force and effect of law, to safeguard the health of the people of such city and prevent nuisances and unsanitary conditions, enforce the same, and provide fines and punishments for the violation of such rules and regulations. It may regulate, suppress, and prevent the occurrence of nuisances and shall actively enforce all laws of the State of Nebraska and ordinances of the Municipality relating to matters of sanitation which affect the health and safety of the people.
3. Penalties. Any person who is found to have violated any order, rule or regulation of the Board of Health duly enacted pursuant to the terms of this section shall be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor or such lesser penalty as the Board of Health may provide in such order, rule or regulation. Each instance of violation of this article may be considered a separate offense.


Any and all Ordinances or portions thereof which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




