

ORDINANCE NO. 1320

AN ORDINANCE REVISING CHAPTER 9, SECTION 801 OF THE RALSTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLED ELECTRICAL CODE; ADOPTED BY REERENCE; TO REPEAL PROVISIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND TO AUTHORIZE THAT SAID ORDINANCE BE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALSTON, NEBRASKA.

That on the 13th day of March, 2023, the City of Ralston Planning Commission conducted a regularly scheduled public hearing at which it considered the revised Electrical Code.

And that on the 2nd day of May, 2023 the Ralston City Council conducted a regularly scheduled public hearing at which it considered revising Chapter 9, Section 801 of the Ralston Municipal Code titled Electrical Code; Adopted by Reference. Upon consideration of such, the Ralston City Council approved the revision of Chapter 9, Section 801 so that the passage of this ordinance shall read as follows:

§ ELECTRICAL CODE; ADOPTED BY REFERENCE.

To provide certain minimum standards for safe and stable installation, methods of connection, and uses of materials in the installation of electrical wiring and appliances hereafter erected, constructed, enlarged, altered, repaired and relocated, the National Electrical Code, as revised and adopted by the Nebraska State Electrical Board pursuant to Nebraska State Statute 81-2104(5), is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as though printed in full herein insofar as said Code does not conflict with the Statutes of the State of Nebraska. One copy of such version of the National Electrical Code, as so amended, shall be kept on file at the office of the City Clerk and made available for public inspection at any reasonable time. The provisions of such National Electrical Code, as so amended, shall be controlling throughout the Municipality and throughout its zoning jurisdiction. (Ref. 71-6406, 81-2104 RS Neb.)

Any and all Ordinances or portions thereof which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


This Ordinance becomes effective after passage by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Ralston, Nebraska and upon its publication as provided by law.


